

The program at Venue C1311 will be a hybrid of on-site and Zoom meetings.




- We recommend you check in advance that your Zoom mic and camera are working. Zoom Meeting test website: http://zoom.us/test/

- > Due to time constraints, please understand that all questions may not be answered.




- > Join Zoom through the "Click to the Online Room (Zoom)" button in Timetable.
